\$ 184

4 Estimated Expenses

Airfare \$ 2,000

Estimate is based on round-trip airfare from the Philadelphia area. Students connecting from other locations should budget for additional travel costs.

Local Travel \$ 200

Travel from Oviedo to Madrid at the conclusion of the program.

Personal Expenses \$ 1,400

Incidental, miscellaneous costs associated with daily living in Oviedo.

Books \$ 200

This estimate is variable by course and instructor.

Smart Phone \$ 80

A mobile phone plan is required for program participation. Costs vary according to plan and usage.

Transcript Fee \$ 9
