2 Program Fee

\$ 4,910

Includes visa fees; housing with a family; three meals per day in Oviedo; select excursions and meals during orientation in Madrid; and travel from orientation to the program location.

3 University Services Fee

Compulsory, comprehensive fee that funds a number of campus services including instructional equipment, e-mail access, and lab facilities.
