Pennsylvania Resident	\$ 9,804	Students will be charged Temple University's Non-Matriculated rate according to their permanent residency (Pennsylvania or Out of State). Single Room	\$ 4,200	Program-arranged housing assumes self-catered accommodations for the dates listed.

4 Course Fees	variable	Certain courses are billed a compulsory fee for excursions, labs, or materials. These fees are paid in yen directly to Temple Japan after arrival.

Airfare	\$ 1,300	Estimate is based on round-trip airfare from the Philadelphia area. Students connecting from other locations should budget for additional travel costs.
Meals	\$ 2,200	Based on the cost of meals prepared in program-arranged housing facilities.
Personal Expenses	\$ 2,200	Incidental, miscellaneous costs associated with daily living in the study city.
Books/Supplies	\$ 250	This estimate is variable by course and instructor.
Japanese National Health Insurance	\$ 60	Mandatory for visa-sponsored students.
Visa	\$ 75	Based on the application fee through the Consulate-General of Japan in New York with estimated shipping. Fees vary by jurisdiction.
Smart Phone	\$ 200	A mobile phone plan is required for program participation. Costs vary according to plan and usage.
Transcript Fee	\$ 9	Visiting students will need to purchase a transcript to transfer credits back to their institution. For more information: https://registrar.temple.edu/
