Course Fees	variable	Certain courses are billed a compulsory fee for excursions, labs, or materials. Fees are listed in the course listing and billed with registration.			
Rome Permit Fee	\$ 280	Academic year students whose program extends beyond 180 days will need to pay a permit to stay fee (permesso di soggiorno).

Airfare	\$ 1,900	This estimate is based on round-trip airfare from the Philadelphia area. Students connecting from other locations should budget for additional travel costs.			
Meals	\$ 2,500	Based on the cost of meals prepared in program-arranged housing facilities.			
Personal Expenses	\$ 2,500	Incidental, miscellaneous costs associated with daily living in Rome.			
Books	\$ 500	This estimate is variable by course and instructor.			
Visa	\$ 160	Includes the application fee required for batch processing through the Consulate General of Italy in Philadelphia. Fees in other jurisdictions vary.			
Smart Phone	\$ 200	A mobile phone plan is required for program participation. Costs vary according to plan and usage.			
Transcript Fee	\$ 9	Visiting students will need to purchase a transcript to transfer credits back to their institution. For more information: https://registrar.temple.edu/
