1 Tuition

2 Program Fee

\$ 5,290

Estimate includes visa fees; housing with a family; three meals per day in Oviedo; select excursions and meals during orientation in Madrid; and travel from orientation to the program location.

3 University Services Fee

\$ 528

Compulsory, comprehensive fee that funds a number of campus services including instructional equipment, e-mail access, and lab facilities.

4 Estimated Expenses

Airfare	\$ 1,100	Estimate is based on round-trip airfare from the Philadelphia area. Students connecting from other locations should budget for additional travel costs.
Local Travel	\$ 150	Travel from Oviedo to Madrid at the conclusion of the program.
Personal Expenses	\$ 2,900	Incidental, miscellaneous costs associated with daily living in Oviedo.
Books	\$ 200	This estimate is variable by course and instructor.
Spanish Health Insurance	\$ 300	Required health insurance from a company authorized to operate in Spain.
Smart Phone	\$ 200	A mobile phone plan is required for program participation. Costs vary according to plan and usage.
Transcript Fee	\$ 9	Visiting students will need to purchase a transcript to transfer credits back to their institution. For more information: https://registrar.temple.edu/
