Airfare	\$ 2,000	Estimate is based on round-trip airfare from the Philadelphia area. Students connecting from other locations should budget for additional travel costs.
Meals	\$ 2,000	Based on the cost of meals prepared in program-arranged housing facilities.
Personal Expenses	\$ 2,000	Incidental, miscellaneous costs associated with daily living.
