##### Temple Students

Rome Program Fees include a \$375 program fee. For non-Temple students who are Pennsylvania residents attending Pennsylvania public universities, Rome Program Fees also include a \$600 non-Temple student surcharge. For all other non-Temple students, Rome Program Fees include the program fee and an \$800 non-Temple student surcharge.

## ESTIMATES FOR NON-BILLABLE COSTS

In addition to the costs that appear on your bill, we provide the following **estimates** for items that do not appear on your bill and for which you should budget. All estimated costs are subject to change and should be used as a guideline only.

- In addition to the items above, students should budget additional money if they plan to undertake personal travel outside of Rome.
- Additional expenses may include optional trip-cancellation/interruption insurance, travel to a specific departure city for a direct flight, etc. and will vary based on factors such as plan purchased, flight availability, and immigration rules.
- We recommend that students follow the exchange rate prior to and while abroad; [oanda](#) is a useful currency exchange website.
