The following costs will appear on your Temple University bill: tuition; Japan program fee; Japan housing (where applicable). All costs are for one semester of study.

Japanese National Health Insurance	\$60	<i>Mandatory for visa-sponsored students</i>
Required Travel-related COVID Testing	\$300-450	<i>Varies according to provider and insurance. Testing required to return to the U.S. costs approximately \$150-250 in Japan and is not covered by insurance.</i>
Consular Visa Fees and Expenses	Varies	<i>Varies according to location and citizenship. This may include costs such as a visa fee, postage, and/or travel costs if in-person appointments are required.</i>
Smart Phone	\$120	<i>Varies according to plan & usage. All Temple Japan study abroad students are required to have a working smart phone (either a U.S. number or a local Japanese number) for the duration of the program.</i>
Transcript	\$8.75	<i>Non-Temple students requiring a transcript will order one through TUPortal. Visit Temple’s Registrar’s website for instructions.</i>

If you are planning any personal travel outside of Tokyo, you should budget additional funds. Depending on conditions, Temple Japan study abroad students may be prohibited from traveling outside of Japan during the program.

To protect funds committed toward a study abroad experience, we encourage you to consider purchasing individual trip cancellation insurance which is available through many travel agents and insurance companies.
